- Supervision of the North Polers, ensuring all visitors are safe, following instructions and respecting the equipment and props.

- Helping with reception, check-in or operating the tills and answering questions.

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- Cashing up and ensuring that all finances are in order and all paperwork is in order.
- Opening and closing up, understanding all procedures, safety requirements, risk assessments and ensuring that everything is followed as it should be.
- Ensuring the whole experience is clean, safe, well maintained and picture perfect
- Ensuring safeguarding policies and best practices are followed.
- Creating shift rotas, managing team, hours and budgets and ensuring that all HR procedures are being followed.
- Ensuring customers are made aware of the work of The Hideaway, and inviting them to come along to play there too.
- Serving customers in a pleasant and courteous manner.
- Working with the wider Hidden Treasure team around maintenance, marketing, finances and any other operational aspects.
